

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

For a peaceful and productive classroom environment, students are requested to follow these guidelines while attending courses online or on-campus.

WHEN ATTENDING CLASSES AT JBV CAMPUS-

- 1. Be punctual.
- 2. Maintain a cordial, friendly and pleasant atmosphere.
- 3. Respect the JBV staff and property.
- 4. Do not smoke, chew tobacco or consume drugs or alcohol on the campus.
- 5. Do not bring non-vegetarian food (e.g., meat, fish and poultry) to the campus.
- 6. Do not litter.
- 7. Do not bring family members or friends into the campus except on specific days, which you will be notified about. (You may bring your child only if he/she is enrolled in the Balwadi.)
- 8. Do not celebrate birthdays/anniversaries during class hours.
- 9. Do not distribute gifts/sweets to peers or teachers on occasions.
- 10. Be responsible for your personal belongings and refrain from carrying valuable items to the campus.
- 11. Hand over all lost items to teachers.
- 12. Ensure that the toilets and wash basins are used properly.
- 13. Switch off mobile phones or put them on silent mode during class.
- 14. Be dressed appropriately on the campus.
- 15. Wear a helmet when entering the campus on a two-wheeler.
- 16. Wear the 3-month ID card at all times while on campus.
- 17. Drop the feedback forms in the suggestion box placed in the Vocational Block (student identities will remain confidential).

WHEN ATTENDING ONLINE CLASSES AT JBV -

- 1. Be on time for the classes. Do not disturb the class by joining late.
- 2. Join within the first 5 mins of starting the class (as the class will be locked after that, and entries will not be allowed).
- 3. Keep the video mode on for the entire duration of the class, otherwise you may not be marked as present in the class.
- 4. Attend the entire class as the attendance will be taken at any time
- 5. Dress suitably for the online class
- 6. Maintain a cordial, friendly and pleasant atmosphere during the class.
- 7. Do not pass personal comments or talk about a topic that does not pertain to the class.
- 8. Respect your teachers and give their feedback (positive or negative) in an appropriate manner via email or in the mode asked for.
- 9. Ensure that no family member /friends/ children/ pets are in the room where you are attending an online class.
- 10. Attend 70% of online classes and complete your assignment, otherwise you will not be eligible for the Jamnalal Bajaj Vishwaneedam (JBV) participation certificate.
- 11. Please give the correct name on the admission form as once the name is given, it will not be changed and will also be used in the participation certificates.
